FCM Funding Climate Adaptation

Element	Grant Details
Max grant	\$1M
Cost sharing	60%, plus 10-20% in Oliver's context
Duration	Up to 3 years
Municipal plans	Alignment with the community energy and emissions plan, and the corporate energy and emissions plan
Examples of projects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cooling and warming centre upgrades • Enhancing municipal service levels to respond to climate risks • Installing back-up power on critical infrastructure • Upgrading public structures to reduce the risks associated with climate hazards • Installing green infrastructure (e.g., rain gardens) • Can include mobile assets

 - Maintain drinking water and water to supply fire fighting efforts

Option 2

- Community energy and emissions plan
- Corporate energy and emissions plan
- Dedicated (contract) role to mobilize/animate the plans
- 3 years at \$60,000 per year



Financials

Source	Option 1	Option 2
FCM LLCA (this grant) 70%	\$273,000	\$126,000
LGCAP* 30%	\$0	\$54,000 over three years (\$17k per year)
Financial plan (2025 + 2026) 30%	\$117,000 over two years (\$58.5k per year)	\$0
Total	\$390,000	\$180,000

*Assumes ongoing funding
