


### Organic Waste Collection Program Engagement Results Summary

#### **Concerns Clarification**

Based on a review of the comments about concerns, the majority of concerns (approximately 61%) were related to participants wanting the program to start sooner; not with the actual program.

#### **Qualitative Themes**

Summary and example quotes are included in the written report:

- Environmental and program benefits
- Animals, pests, and heat
- Implementation costs, timelines, and roll out
- Ongoing education
- The facility and composting process
- General/other concerns, including the change in garbage pick-up scheduling

Merged the three qualitative questions






- First one: 25 deep/engaged conversations
- Second one: 37 deep/engaged conversation
- Both: 117 hellos, do not want to engage, or live in Osoyoos or RDOS
- Similar themes to the qualitative survey questions
- Overall, residents really liked the Town coming to them
